Make popcorn for student incentives and parties. This is a rotating schedule and takes approximately 2 hours a week.

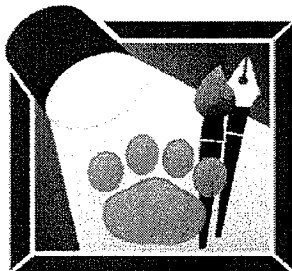
READING IS FUNDAMENTAL (RIF)
