

Participation/Tennis Shoes:



Tennis shoes are required for physical education class. It is important that proper tennis shoes are worn for the safety of your child and the safety of others as well. A good tennis shoe has arch support and is secured with Velcro or tied with laces across the top of the shoe. Listed below are examples of shoes that do not meet acceptable standards for phy ed class.

- Roller shoes which are shoes with wheels on them.
- Skateboard shoes (flat arched) shoes that do not give proper support to the ankles, feet and legs.
- Tennis shoes that do not have full support around the ankle. (e.g.) slip on tennis shoes or tennis shoes with a strap around the back.
- Loosely laced tennis shoes that are not tied and secured on top of the shoes.
- Hiking boots or plat form shoes.
