

Fernbrook BEHAVIORAL EXPECTATIONS

OUR GOAL IS TO PROVIDE A SAFE AND RESPECTFUL LEARNING ENVIRONMENT!

REMAIN IN ASSIGNED AREA

- Stay in assigned seat in cafeteria until dismissed by adult in charge. **May not enter classroom.**
- Remain on playground, plan for weather, **may not reenter building**; see para in emergency.

FOLLOW DIRECTIONS BY ADULTS

- Quickly and quietly **without discussion**

KEEP HANDS, FEET AND OBJECTS TO YOURSELF

- You are responsible for keeping your **body under control**.
- Play fighting, bear hugs, **tackling, rough play** are not permitted.
- Fighting will lead to an **immediate behavior slip** (no further warning).
- Throwing a snowball may lead to a **behavior slip** (no further warning).

WALK AT ALL TIMES

- Running with your body under control at recess and in gym class is permitted.

USE QUIET VOICES AND PROPER LANGUAGE

- Use **quiet voices** in the lunch room and hallways out of respect for others.
- **Teasing/bullying**, disrespectful, inappropriate language/gestures or behavior **are not permitted**.

USE COMMON SENSE - If there is a chance you might get hurt or hurt someone else, **DON'T DO IT!**

- Use playground equipment (slides, swings, etc.) in a **safe manner**. Put things away when done.
- **Electronic items** (CD players, radios, video games, MP3 players, etc.) hard balls and bats, trading cards, **are not permitted**. Leave your toys at home. Cell phones are permitted **only with permission**.
- **DRESS CODE** – Clothing must be **appropriate for school activities** - 1.5" straps, must cover midsection, fingertip length (shorts or skirt), may not be immodest or have offensive language/images, no underwear showing, headwear, sprayed hair coloring or hazardous items (pins, chains, etc.).
- **INTERNET ACCESS** – Students are not allowed to use the internet **without staff supervision**. Violators may lose computer privileges.

TYPICAL BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION PROCEDURE

1. Warning – adult will help you understand correct behavior.
 - Dangerous (snow balls, fighting) or chronic behavior may lead to an immediate behavior slip.
2. Time out or red card
3. Behavior Slip
 - Must be signed by student, parent and teacher
 - 1 day detention, 3 days detention, 5 or more days lunch/recess detention (behavior plan)
 - Served in the office

WEAPONS POLICY: If you discover a weapon, turn it in to an adult **IMMEDIATELY** (no problem); if it is discovered by someone else it will be confiscated & there will be consequences.
