***TENNIS SHOES FOR PHY ED DAYS:**

- All students are required to wear basic tennis shoes to Phy Ed.
- Platform shoes (extra thick soles), or a tennis shoe with a raised heel or no backs are NOT acceptable. Hiking boots and “slip-ons” are also inappropriate.
- For safety reasons, children who do not wear proper shoes will not be allowed to participate in Phy Ed.
- Any child who is likely to forget to bring or wear acceptable Phy Ed shoes to school should keep a separate pair in their school locker at all times. Students who are without tennis shoes three (3) times in a trimester may receive detention.
- Kindergarten and first grade students who cannot tie their own shoes tightly are encouraged to have shoes with Velcro fasteners. A lot of Phy Ed time is wasted when the Phy Ed teacher must continually tie, re-tie, or get knots out of shoes.
