(to be shared in the classroom)
- || 2 folders (**NOT** yellow)
- || 1 wide lined notebook
- || A 12 inch/cm ruler
- || 1 box of colored pencils
- || Pencil/crayon box for supplies
- || 2 boxes of Kleenex
- || 2 containers of baby wipes
- || 1 (**1 1/2 inch**) 3-ring notebook
- || \$5.00 donation for classroom activities

**Third Grade**

- || 4 dozen yellow #2 pencils
- || 1 pack lo odor dry erase markers
- || 1 box Classic colored markers
- || 1 box 16 (or more) count crayons
- || 1 glue bottle, 2 glue sticks
- || 1 pair pointed scissors (like Fiskars)
- || 1 yellow highlighter
- || 1 12 inch ruler with centimeters marked
