Click on the **Sign In** button after you enter the username and password for your grade level.

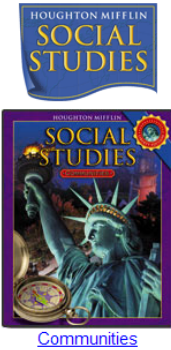
In this example, a 3rd grade student enters **online03** for the username and **book03** for the password.

How to navigate the Student Edition

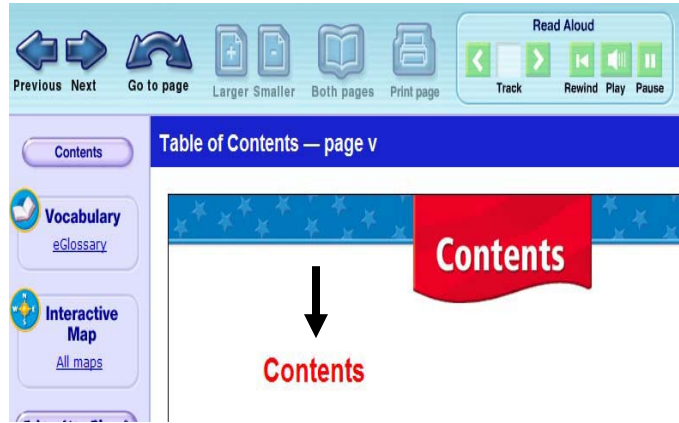
After you've logged into the Student Edition website you will be prompted to click on text book to enter the online book.
