## FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions):

**Q:** How do we help?

**A:** It's easy – and fun! Your child will bring home the Fun Night pack. There will be fliers and cheering items inside. Once you arrive at the restaurant, walk inside and tell them that you're here and leave a small stack of fliers at each register.

- Stand on the sidewalk beside the drive through, and give the fliers to people walking in or preparing to go through the drive-through.
- Be prepared to explain the program.

**Q:** What do I say?

**A:** Your "sales pitch" will be minimal, as we're not really selling anything. I usually start with, "***This doesn't cost a thing – it's free***" and that usually gets their attention. From there, ask them to please turn the flier in when they pay for their food, and then McDonald's will donate 20% of the proceeds to our Elementary School.

**Q:** What time do we need to be there and how long does it last?

**A:** It goes from 5:00 to 7:00. Consider splitting the time with your child's best friend!

**Q:** Is there anything else we need to do?

**A:** Have your child return the fun pack and all the cheering materials to Kristy Chouinard, the volunteer coordinator, the next day.
