Student Supplies 2007 - 2008

Kindergarten

In order to provide consistency of student supplies, the kindergarten teachers will purchase most of the items needed for their students. A \$20 donation is requested. Students should furnish the following items themselves:

1. Plastic school box
(Cigar-box size- 8" x 5-1/2" x 2")
2. School bag (**LARGE** backpack)
3. 1 pkg. of stickers (contribution to classroom)
4. 2 pocket folders - labeled
5. 3 pre-washed white t-shirts, labeled and in separate ziploc bags. Please send t-shirts that will fit your child in the spring!
6. 1 box of tissues (optional)
7. **Please label all clothing**
8. Phy Ed shoes (*see note)

First Grade

 2. 2 doz. #2 pencils to be shared (not Pentech) sharpened
 3. 8-12 pack colored pencils-sharpened
 4. pencil sharpener
 5. Crayons (24 count)
 4. Crayola washable markers broad tip, **classic colors - 8 count**
 5. **Elmer's** white school glue 2 (4 oz.) bottles (**no gel**)
 6. Bookbag or backpack (**no wheels, please**)
 7. Paper folders - 3 (yellow, blue, novelty)
 8. 3 zippered pencil pouches (mesh nylon, most durable)
 9. Box of Prang or Crayola watercolor paints (8 colors)
 10. Fiskars for Kids scissors (metal blades)

10. Bookbag or backpack - please avoid buying backpacks with rubber bottoms and/or wheels. Must fit in 1/2 locker.
11. 2 notebooks - **spiral** (wide-lined without perforations)
12. 2 red-colored pens
13. Package of colored pencils - 12 count
14. Stickers for classroom rewards (optional)
15. Plastic desk cover (18" x 24")
16. Pencil sharpener w/receptacle, screw on lid
17. 1 pocket folder and 1 pencil for music
18. Disinfectant wipes
19. Phy Ed shoes (*see note)

Fourth Grade

1. *1 3-ring zip binder (folders must fit inside)
2. 4-6 #2 sharpened pencils
3. 8" x 10-1/2" wide-lined loose-leaf paper (package)
4. Colored pencils
5. Markers
6. Crayons (24 count)
7. Scissors (Fiskars type)
8. 12" **wooden** ruler (**metric** and standard)
9. White school glue (no gel or colors)
10. Glue stick (2-3 pack)
11. 3 red ink pens
12. Small school box
13. *Large box of tissue (contribution to classroom)
14. 6 pocket folders without fasteners in the following colors: red, purple, green, blue, orange, yellow
15. *2 novelty folders without fasteners
16. Odorless dry erase marker- dark color
17. * pocket folder and 1 pencil for music
18. 2 spiral notebooks wide-rule, 70 ct: 1 yellow, 1 green
19. Phy Ed shoes (*see note)
20. *Assignment notebook (to be purchased at school)
21. *Backpack must fit in 1/2 locker! (This includes those with wheels.)

Note: Individual teachers may require additional supplies.
It may be necessary to replenish supplies throughout the year.
*If ordering School Toolbox, starred items must be purchased in addition.



Fifth Grade



1. 4 sharpened pencils - #2
2. 2 blue or black ballpoint pens, 2 red correcting pens
3. 2 standard erasable pens
4. 2 thin black flair markers
5. Standard eraser caps
6. 8 oz. (small) white glue and 2 8 oz. glue sticks
7. Crayons
8. Colored Pencils
9. 2 highlighters
10. Phy Ed shoes (*see note)
11. Ruler (metric/standard)
12. Scissors
13. Large box of tissue (contribution to classroom)
14. 8 pocket folders (red/math, blue/social studies, green/science-health, yellow/spelling-language, purple/reading, choice/music *)
15. 6 notebooks (red, blue, green, yellow, purple, other*)
16. Watercolor markers (not permanent)
17. 1 pocket folder and 1 pencil for music
18. Large zipper bag for pencils/art supplies
19. Calculator (to be purchased at school-optional)
20. Assignment notebook (to be purchased at school)
21. Dry eraser and 3 *odorless* pens for whiteboards (blue or black only)
22. Small hand-held pencil sharpener (no battery or electric)

*Label folders/notebooks with student name/subject

If you can't find the right colors of folders and notebooks, you can use construction paper and contact paper to cover folders and notebooks

Sixth Grade

1. #2 pencils
2. Pens: black or blue erasable, and 1 red
3. Colored pencils
4. Watercolor markers (thin tip)
5. Crayons (24 count or larger)
6. 2 fine line black flair
7. 12" Ruler (metric and inches)
8. Bottle of Elmer's glue
9. Scissors
10. 7-2 pocket folders (1 each of red, blue, green, yellow, purple, orange, 1 student choice)
11. 7 wide-ruled spiral notebooks (red=math, blue=social studies, green=science, purple=reading, yellow=spelling, orange=language arts) (colors coded with folders except orange)
12. 3-hole loose-leaf paper (wide lined)
13. Eraser
14. 1 extra spiral notebook
15. Tissue - 1 box
16. 1 pocket folder and 1 pencil for music
17. Phy Ed shoes (*see note)
18. Assignment notebooks (to be purchased at school)
19. NO TRAPPER KEEPERS OR 'PUTTY' ERASERS

*Phy Ed shoes - For safety purposes, tennis shoes should not have a heel, platform, or hooks (hiking boot.) Tennis shoes can be left at school, or worn to school on phy ed days.
