ART ADVENTURE

Discuss with students the elements of art using art prints from the Minneapolis Institute of Arts. This will take place during the month of January.

AT-HOME ASSISTANT

Projects that can be done at home. Materials sent to-and-from school with your child.

CAFETERIA

Assist with serving lunch when needed between 11:30 a.m. – 1:10 p.m.. You receive a free lunch!

CLASSROOM ASSISTANT

Help teachers with various tasks, such as paperwork, decorations, working with children.

CLASSROOM TUTOR

Work with one-to-four students as needed with reading or math.

CULTURAL ENRICHMENT

Present in various classrooms cultures that you have experienced.

FAMILY & CRISIS VOLUNTEER

Assist families in crisis as needed with things such as food etc.

GRADE-LEVEL PROGRAMS

Make scenery, props, costumes or other things for various programs.

MEDIA CENTER

Assist with sorting and shelving books, help students find books, filing, and more.

POPCORN POPPER

Use school's popcorn machine to make popcorn for classroom rewards and parties on Tuesdays and/or Fridays when requested.

RESEARCH PAPERS

Assist students with note-taking and paper preparation.

TECHNOLOGY ASSISTANT

Assist in the classroom or media center with computer projects – training provided as needed.
