

Long Lake Conservation Center Packing List

When preparing for your Long Lake experience, keep in mind that appropriate clothing will make your visit to Long Lake more enjoyable and enriching. Here in the north woods, we are not concerned with fashion. We are concerned with practicality. Warm outerwear is **essential** at all times of the year. Weather at Long Lake can change rapidly. It can get very cold, especially in the evening. **Think layers** when packing clothes.

Students may bring **1 suitcase or duffle bag and their sleeping bag/bed roll** to be stored in the trailer. They may bring a small bag or backpack on the bus. We encourage students to pack themselves and to practice rolling up their sleeping bag since they will be responsible for this when leaving Long Lake. Items should be labeled clearly with their name.
