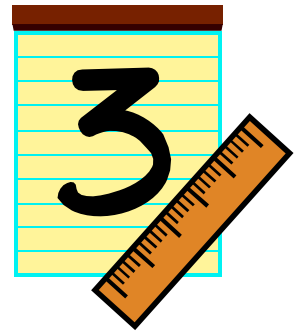


Three for Me Program!
