Welcome to first grade at Woodland. I am looking forward to working with you and your child.

The Language Arts theme for September will be "Guess Who?"

In math we will be reviewing some of the concepts learned in kindergarten.

Each evening your child will be bringing home a Take Home Folder. Please check the Take Home Folder for completed work, and school information. The Take Home Folder needs to be returned to school daily.

The first grade behavior plan supports Woodland's building wide discipline policy. This plan focuses on positive reinforcement and compliments our character education program.

A pocket chart assists students with making appropriate choices. Should a student choose inappropriate behavior, a warning is given and the card is turned, if a second warning is issued the student's card is removed from the pocket. Following a third warning a white slip is issued. On Fridays, those students who did not receive

white slips for the week will earn time to enjoy an activity of their choice.
