Academic Updates

Math: This month students will be working on addition and subtraction word problems. When completing word problems, students are expected to show their work write an equation and label their answers. Students will continue to receive homework most nights.

Language Arts: A new monthly reading calendar is came home for students to track their November reading minutes. Students are expected to read one AR book a week and pass a quiz on that book. We have little time to independently read at school so students are asked to be responsible by reading at home. Students can read by themselves, read to someone else or listen to someone read.

This month students will be working on classifying, categorizing, author's purpose and making predictions during leveled reading and language arts..

Health: We did a very short Chapter in Health called About Myself and Others. We talked about feelings such as anger, sadness and stress. Students made a feelings booklet, writing and drawing about specific times they have experienced different feelings. These booklets have been sent home.



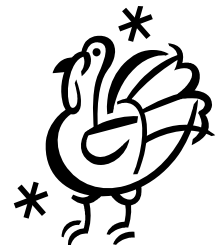
