- Number families & Time

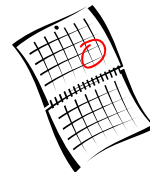
 Thank you for helping your child remember to return their library book each day so they may check out a different book. The children are able to find the fiction and nonfiction books, favorite authors, and easy reader books.

The date is Friday, May 14th. This is a fun field trip and I hope you or a family member will be able to accompany your child.

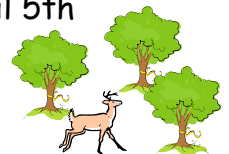
 Each child will be creating a page for the class alphabet book at the computer lab. They will be using Hyper-Studio to create their illustrations and writing.
