Approval of 2/05/08 Meeting Minutes

- A motion was made and approved to accept the minutes from the February 5, 2008 SILT meeting.

Principal's Update:

- **Follow-up on Learning Lab from last meeting:**
 - Mr. Hill provided data on student credits prior to enrollment in the Learning Lab and during 2nd trimester participation in the class.
 - At this time the data is inconclusive – more time is needed to evaluate the program outcomes.
 - Students will have the option to opt out of the class 3rd trimester. Additional data will be collected during 3rd trimester.
 - Maple Grove's Learning Lab is similar to the lab at the OALC.

Women's History Month:

- SILT members were asked to bring ideas for Women's History Month (March) to today's meeting.
- Krista shared ideas she brainstormed including: table tents with info about different famous women in history; writing a thank you note to one woman who has made a difference in your life (during SSR time); power point with facts, pictures, stories, etc. about famous female inventors – would scroll throughout the day on the announcements; feature books by women or about women in the media center; internet scavenger hunt on famous historical women.
- Alicia suggested having mystery readers (staff) share information about women in history during the morning announcements.
- Albert will facilitate the activities for Women's History Month and will send out an e-mail to staff asking for volunteers to help with the various activities. Albert will also purchase thank you cards.
- Mr. Hill will look into a speaker for Women's History Month.
- Leann asked about reviving the Multi-Cultural Club. This will be an agenda item for the summer meeting.

Other:

- Staffing timeline: Mr. Hill should know the OALC staffing allocation by March 17th and staff should know about their positions for next year by April 25th. Note: This is the current timeline – the special board meeting date has been moved to March 11th.
