Meeting Commenced at 8:05am

Principal's update:

- System Action to Eliminate Racial Disparity in Suspensions/Expulsions – new district partnership to promote community engagement and outreach.
- Osseo Chamber City Council Member toured our facility
- James would like to get more involved in community events/build relationships
- Staffing – March 9th James receives allocation. March 10th staff meeting to give basic info – how many FTE, etc. James would like to add a SILT meeting on Mark Reporting 3/12 if everyone agrees (time TBD). Impacted staff will be notified prior to 3/16/10. After SILT meets, James wants a staff meeting on 3/16 to unveil staff allocations for 2010-2011. On 3/17, James has his staffing meeting at the district level to finalize the staffing plan.
- Student behavior tends to escalate in the spring – we all need to be diligent about confronting PDA, etc. In addition, we need to be very cautious and aware of students in the bathrooms or other areas of the school. Staff members need to be diligent about making sure staff workrooms, etc. are locked.

Follow up on conferences

There was no significant difference in conference parental attendance on Mondays vs. Thursdays, however, Mondays have less of an impact on other district activities.

Plan for truancy swoop
