

Policy 922 - Non-use of Chemicals on School Premises

I. General Statement

To promote the health and well-being of all community members, employees, and students as they use the school buildings, grounds, and other facilities of the District, use of prohibited drugs on District premises is prohibited. This prohibition is effective for all persons while on District property, in District vehicles or contracted vehicles, and during District affiliated activities during all hours of every calendar day.

II. Definitions

- A. "Use" includes the manufacture, sale, distribution, dispensation, transfer, possession or use of any prohibited drug.
- B. "Prohibited drugs" are defined as any legally-defined controlled substance, any alcoholic beverage, any substance being used to achieve a mood-altered state, and any non-prescription or prescription medication not being used in accordance with the manufacturer's guidelines.

III. Notification

Notice of the policy will be made in publications of the Community Education Department.

IV. Implementation

It is the responsibility of the District and its employees to notify the law enforcement authorities when violations of law are observed. Violations of this policy, whether or not violations of law, are to be reported to the Community Education Department.
