COST

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. I live in the Osseo area but my student attends a charter school/private school in Brooklyn Park (or Maple Grove area), can my child participate in Freedom Schools?

A. No. You must attend an Osseo Area Schools ISD 279 school. If you decide to enroll your student into Osseo Area Schools ISD 279, please contact the enrollment center. You will need to provide enrollment verification in order to attend Freedom Schools.

Q. My student will begin Kindergarten in the Fall of 2019, can she/he attend Freedom Schools?

A. No. K-7 students only. Students must have completed Kindergarten and be entering into first grade in the Fall 2019.

Q. I heard that Freedom Schools is for students with an IEP.

A. False. All of Osseo Area Schools ISD 279 summer programs have experienced staff and accept students with IEPs. We are a summer literacy enrichment program. We focus on reading and the love of reading.

Q. Is registration only online?

A. Yes. Our online registration works best on computers (not cell phones). If you need assistance or access to a computer, contact your student's school. Our equity specialist are located in every elementary and middle schools and will be able to help you.

Q. What happens if I'm later than the 3:00 pm pick up time?

A. You must pick up at 3:00 pm. We do not have extended day care. There are late fees if picked up after 3:00 pm. Many of our Freedom Schools families *pull together* with other families to create a parent pick up schedule.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Enrollment for summer 2019 begins Jan. 22. We will continue to take scholars until classes are full, at which point we will begin a waitlist. Register early! Classes are limited and fill very quickly!

1. **Create an account at [Osseo.ce.eleyo.com](https://osseo.ce.eleyo.com)** - This allows you access to program information all summer.
2. **Complete the online registration form, a separate online registration must be completed for each child attending.**
3. **Admission is based on classroom and grade level spaces.** Upon admission, you will be notified by email. You must confirm your acceptance. If we do not hear back from you, we will open the space for another scholar to participate.
4. **Attend mandatory Parent Orientation.** More information will be provided upon acceptance.
